Parking and Transportation Services – Notice of Delinquent Violations

Policy

In accordance with the California Vehicle Code (CVC), Parking and Transportation Services has established the following procedures for processing the notice of a delinquent parking violation.

Per CVC 40206, if the payment of the parking penalty is not received by the University within 21 days of the initial notice of the parking violation under Section <u>40202</u>, CSUF Parking & Transportation Services shall deliver to the registered owner a notice of delinquent parking violation.

Responsibilities

The Vice President for Administration and Finance/CFO has the overall responsibility for the rules, processes and procedures that govern delinquent parking violation notices.

Scope

Delivery of a notice of a delinquent parking violation under this section may be made by personal service or by first-class mail addressed to the registered owner, as shown on records of the Department of Motor Vehicles.
