Electric Vehicle (EV) Parking is available across campus to charge an electric vehicle.

CSUF Students, Faculty, Staff

- A valid CSUF permit is required to park in an EV charging space.
- Students who own a semester permit may complete the [Student EV Permit Application](#) for a free supplemental EV Permit.
- Faculty/Staff with a semester or annual permit may complete the [Faculty/Staff EV Permit Application](#) for a free supplemental EV Permit.
- EV Permit holders may enter the "Connections Code" on their ChargePoint account to receive subsidized EV charging.
- Sign up with [ChargePoint](#) to receive a membership card.

Guests and Visitors

- A valid CSUF permit is required to park in an EV charging space.
- The price to charge is \$0.40 per kilowatt hour.

A vehicle that is parked in an EV space and not connected for electric charging purposes is subject to citation and/or tow per CVC Section 22511. Vehicles parked in Electric Vehicle parking spaces with a posted time restriction may not exceed the posted time limit and are subject to citation per CVC 21113A.
